





Day 2 **Full Day Thunderball Grotto**

The Thunderball Grotto is a famous cay in the Exumas, one of the Bahamas islands that is a major destination. It is famous for the James Bond Cave, which is where several 007 movies have been shot. From Nassau's head South to The Thunderball Grotto is accessible by ferry, which is for sure an interesting 80 miles trip. The activities involve Snorkeling, kayaking, and paddleboarding, shark watching and petting, scuba diving, watching Iguanas, and swimming with the swimming pigs. You can also indulge in enthralling beach sports. The Thunderball Grotto is surrounded by other cays, most notable the Staniel cay and the Big Major Cay. After breakfast, you will be transferred on the ferry to Thunderball Grotto for a day of adventure in the clear waters. The views of the cays and Thunderball Grotto are scenic, and the tropical weather is just perfect for the day's activities. You can begin with a snorkeling adventure in the deep, clear blue waters, guided by experienced guides who know just the right places for you to view the fish and beautiful coral reefs. Alternatively, you can indulge in the thrill of the kayaks or the stand-up paddleboards, which offer an almost similar experience. For refreshments, you can sample Bahamian barbecues and cocktails.

You will then experience the Exuma wildlife where you can indulge in activities such as shark watching and petting, feeding the pigs. You can also add to the thrill by swimming with the sharks and the swimming pigs, which are part of the rich history of the Thunderball Grotto. All this time, you will be in the company of a guide who will explain to you the rich history of the Thunderball Grotto. This site has been used to film 2 James Bond movies, and as such, some dive sites are named after him. There are plane wrecks in the water, which were bombers used in World War II, which will tickle the nerves of any scuba diver. The Thunderball Grotto provides diving depths of between 30 and 45 feet which are more than enough for an unforgettable adventure. You can conclude this activity by watching, feeding, and walking with the iguanas at the Guana Cays as you enjoy the scenic views of the white sandy beach. In the afternoon, you get to indulge with the locals, learn their history, culture and sample the foods. The menus provide an opportunity to try the Bahamian and Exuman shafish fry, coconut shrimp, Bahamian Rock Lobster, cracker spiny lobster, and the Bahamian seasoned and smoked pig.


You can water down the sumptuous meals with the smash cocktails. For dessert, you can sample the rum cakes and crumbles. There are plenty of side dishes and juices. Today you will head to the Harisson Cave. The Barbados Tourism Encyclopedia describes Harrisons Cave as one of the Seven Wonders of Barbados. At the cave, you will board electrically operated trams that will take you through the extensive system of caverns while experienced guides will give you historical information. The Barbados Harrison's cave is truly a phenomenon of nature. There are excellent galleries of stalactites hanging from the cave's roof and stalagmites reaching up from the ground, with emerald pools and pillars that have joined over thousands of years. The dramatic lighting will enhance your visit. Depending on the crowds, your time in the cave is approximately 35-45 minutes. From there, you will journey to the magnificent Hunte's Hunte's Botanical Gardens. You will meander along the pathways and find many surprises amongst the lush tropical plants. The rare exotic foliage grows densely in this landscaped gully; amongst them are antiques and other beautiful decorative pieces. You might spot the occasional bird or animal who loves the place as much as you will - it is truly an enchanting experience. Lastly, you will be served refreshments and take in a scenic view of the Barbados landscape as you drive back to the port.

Day 6 St. Nicholas Abbey, Cherry Tree Hill & Animal Flower Cave

St Nicholas Abbey is located in Saint Peter, Barbados, a plantation house, museum, and rum distillery. Colonel Benjamin Berringer built the house in 1658. This house is one of only three genuine Jacobean mansions in the Western Hemisphere. It's similar to the English Jacobean-era manor houses of the first half of the seventeenth century, the period between the Tudor and Georgian styles, beginning in the reign of James I. We visit North Point Barbados for the incredible views. The Animal Flower Cave is also located at North Point, but this tour does not include the entrance fees. From Dec to April, Humpback whales migrate through the Caribbean. North Point is one of the famous viewing sights.







Day 2 Beach, Blue Room and Snorkel Adventure

Today, enjoy great beach hopping, relaxation, and lots of beautiful sunshine. You'll also get an unforgettable snorkel experience in the island's famous cave, the Blue Room. This excursion includes all the sights you must see when traveling to this lovely island. Don't forget your camera! Find a spot and settle in for the scenic boat ride. Your first stop is the Blue Room, an extraordinary, primarily underwater cave located near Santu Pretu. It's easy to see why the cave gets its name. Everything inside the cave reflects the perfect turquoise, Caribbean-blue water. You'll see schools of fish dart in and around the rocky underwater terrain with crystal clear visibility. Notice how even the reflections of splashed waters remain that vivid blue! This cave is simply splendid. Next, you'll dock for a beach break. Either snorkel again or simply swims peacefully in the gentle waters. Bring a bit of cash if you'd like to enjoy a snack or cocktails at one of the beach-side restaurants.

Day 3 Full Day Shete Boca and Snorkel Jeep Tour

After pick-up from the hotel and a safety briefing, your adventure starts at the wide-open desert planes where your guide will tell you about the island's volcanic and coral geological origins with three distinct terraces running for miles along the north coastline of Curacao. Natural blowholes: You will then visit several isolated bays where big breakers crash into the coral cliffs creating natural blowholes where the seawater and foam are sprayed through a chute into the air displaying colorful fountains and rainbows. If the waves are strong enough, you can stand close and let the water sprinkles refresh you. Exotic birds like herons, frigatebirds, and caracaras can be spotted here. Enjoy lunch in the Shete Boka National Park with its rugged and rocky formations where, if the sea allows, you will visit Boka Tabla. This is where the sea and wind have worked together to create a cave in which the waves come crashing in, often giving a splendid show but sometimes flooding the cave completely. Here you will also enjoy a tasty but straightforward picnic lunch—South-West coast. After Shete Boka National Park, you will leave the North-West coast and cross over to the South-West coast of Curacao, where you will notice how the scenery changes completely from a dry arid climate to a hilly green coast. Here, you will find nearly all of Curacao's natural white beaches with turquoise blue waters or locally called playas. At one of these playas, you will go snorkeling, allowing you to discover and enjoy the underwater world of Curacao. Later in the evening, drive back to the hotel for the overnight and dinner.

After being picked up at the pier, you will be transferred to the boat shop which is approximately 30 minutes away. Step aboard your choice of comfortable yet lightning-fast 43 or 50-foot, twin deck Hatteras or Bertram. Your captain and crew will do all the work for you so you can relax and enjoy your tour. Your cruise will take you along the coast past the Spanish water lagoon, the Fuik lagoon, and Duivels klip, which is an inaccessible area of Curaçao. Depending on weather conditions, you will arrive at KleinCuração in approximately 1 hour and 15 minutes. Once on the island, you will have time to stroll the beach, visit the lighthouse, or snorkel the reef.
